new supply of Water Bottles and Water bottle accessories have recently arrived at the Ash Fork Water Service office. Stop in to check them out.

- We have a new type bottle it is BPA free. This is probably the best water storage container material currently on the market.
- We have:
- 7 2 & 3-gallon refrigerator bottles, rectangular in shape with a spout for dispensing. BPA Free ** \$19-\$21
- 2-liter personal size water bottle w/handle and screw cap. Blue and pink, BPA Free ** \$6.50
- 5-gallon regular top, Big Mouth with and without spigot** \$12 to 17.50

3-gallon regular and stubby sizes** \$11.50 1-gallon w/handle ** \$6.00

Ash Fork Water Service has several projects in the works that will improve the water system tremendously. They are:



- New pump house at the original Well Site AF #1. Engineering plans are currently being drafted. We anticipate project starting early Spring and completed by early Fall 2023.
- Drill a new well to replace a broken well. This is scheduled for completion in 2024
- Install approx. 2500' of new water main. Scheduled for completion in 2024.
- Currently a financing application is being reviewed and expected to be submitted to the Arizona Corporation Commission in the next two months. This application is for approval to apply for financing from

Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Az (WIFA).

Projects the application will include:

- Arsenic Treatment plant at AF #1 Well Site,
- 2. Repainting exterior of our 2-water storage tanks,
- 3. Install approx. 6,200' of new water main, and
- 4. Construct a new water standpipe, to supplement the Water office standpipe.

I will be discussing benefits of a new dispensing system in detail in the following months. Some of the highlights include.

- No billing, no late payments, no mis-entered data, no billing cycle
- You can charge your water card right from the unit with your debit or credit card
- Two drop hoses with simultaneously fill ability.

It was great to have our Summer Crew back out there again this year. Although it was a short Summer, we got a few important things accomplished.

- Old refurbished playground equipment was installed (Two spring animals and the elephant slide)
- Playground equipment was repaired and tightened
- Trash picked up, weeds mowed down, and tress trimmed.

We had received three job spots from our NACOG partner but were only able to fill one position.

Thanks to our Summer workers for their hard work. Great Job!


New Prices for Massage Therapy

Prices have been adjusted to suit our community's needs. 10% discounts will still apply to our honored Vets and those on disability. Relief from chronic pain can promote healing and overall health. It's important to the Alchemy Team to keep it accessible, as a cash pay service. Massage Therapy is available with Tania, LMT every Tuesday and Thursday, and now once monthly with BeBe, LMT. Gift certificates are available if you want to spoil someone in need of relief. We are working to get these services covered by Medical Insurances such as Care1st and the VA Community Care Network. Will keep you posted, but it will take awhile to get insurances onboard.

VA Community Care Network: Just a reminder that Daniel Knight, FNP is a VA Community Care Network Provider at the Alchemy Clinic. Veterans who wish to use Daniel for Primary Care may do so with full VA approval. The Veteran must contact their VA home provider team to be referred to Daniel as their new community PCP. The VA, in turn, will contact our office to authorize your appointment with Daniel. We hope this will give Veterans in our community access to in-person services without endless telehealth appointments or having to drive to Prescott or Flagstaff for their care. It is our honor to serve the veterans and their families in our community.

ince 1993, Operation Christmas Child, the world's largest Christmas project of its kind, has been collecting shoeboxes filled with gifts to be delivered to children in

need around the world. The project delivers not only the joy of what, for many kids, may be their first gift ever, but also demonstrates God's love in a tangible way, letting children know they are not alone and not forgotten.

During that time, over 198 million children in over 170 countries and territories have received an Operation Christmas Child shoebox—and hundreds of those boxes have come through the generosity of donors right here in Ash Fork.

The simple gift of a shoebox filled with small items—things like a toothbrush, hair clips, crayons, coloring books, toy cars, a stuffed animal, or school supplies—can be a life-changing treasure for children in areas affected by war, poverty, disaster, famine, and disease.

Some suggested items to pack would be "Wow" items (stuffed animals, dolls, clothing), personal care items (combs, toothbrushes, washcloths, soap), school supplies (pencils, pens, notebooks, scissors, erasers, sharpeners), and toys (balls, yo-yos, jump ropes, puzzles). And feel free to add a personal note, just to let that child know they're special and loved.

Some items that *cannot* be included would be: candy, gum, toothpaste, used or damaged items, war-related items, or anything liquid or breakable.
